Loy Krathong is a favorite festival in Thailand because it is very beautiful and romantic. This is the celebration of the full moon in November. In Thai, Loy means "float" and Krathong means "small, lotus-shaped boat." This is the day when people float krathongs, wash their sins away, and make wishes for the future.

Originally, the krathong was made of banana leaves. A krathong contains food, flowers, candles and coins. The making of a krathong is much more creative these days as many more materials are available. When the day of the festival comes, one lights the candles, makes one's wishes and lets it float away with the current of a river.

Some believe the festival originates from Buddhism.
